



## Azulejo Tinto 2012

An excellent example of the fantastic progress which has been made in Portuguese wine-making in recent years, Azulejo is the distinctive Portuguese white and blue tile shown on the label. Made in the Lisbon area from 40% Castelão, 40% Tinta Roriz (Tempranillo) and 20% Pinot Noir this wine shows a great intensity of fruit with blackberry & raspberry aromas predominating. Medium bodied, with an attractive bright ruby colour, on the palate there is concentrated blackcurrant and berry fruit flavours with oak, vanilla and toffee notes. Aged in traditional oak barriques, it is well balanced with a long and pleasant aftertaste. Best served after allowing to breathe for an hour. Excellent everyday drinking!

Great with light meat dishes, past, and tomato based dishes - and fabulous with chocolate tart.
