

Chateau Lamothe Vincent Reserve Rouge

Founded in 1920, the Château at Montignac has for four generations produced generous wines that have been regularly awarded at various national and international competitions. The diversity of terroirs in the estate's 90 hectares makes it possible to produce wines with expressive aromas and remarkable delicacy.

Deep colour with crimson tints. Brimming with black fruits flavours (black berry, black cherry), red fruits (cassis, crushed strawberry) and liquorice. Mineral, spicy and toasty. Medium-bodied, mouth-filling texture and balance, with ripe and fine tannins. Long on the finish. with red meat, grilled meat and game. Also well suited for pasta, red sauces and cheese. Drink now for full fresh aromatic expression.
