



## **Chateau Lamothe Vincent Bordeaux Superieur “Heritage” Rouge**

Founded in 1920, the Château at Montignac has for four generations produced generous wines that have been regularly awarded at various national and international competitions. The diversity of terroirs in the estate's 90 hectares makes it possible to produce wines with expressive aromas and remarkable delicacy.

Deep cherry red with purple tints. Complex and refined bouquet of ripe red fruits, blackcherry, blackberry, spices and vanilla. Silky attack, then rich and elegant mouth, with the same flavours wrapped in full, well-integrated tannins. Fresh and well-balanced on the long mineral finish.

An ideal match for red meats, lamb, roast duck. Also well suited for pasta, red sauces and cheese. Serve from 62 to 66°F. Ageing potential: up to 10 years
