



Chateau Lamothe-Vincent Heritage Rouge 2017

Founded in 1920, and family owned for four generations, Château Lamothe-Vincent is composed of three main pieces, one lying at Montignac, another situated at Castelveil, the third at Daubèze. The diversity of terroirs in the estate's 90 hectares makes it possible to produce wines with expressive aromas and remarkable delicacy. Making consistently excellent and internationally recognised wines, this is a great cuvée from a great vintage.

You'll be seduced by its red and dark fruit flavours and its delicate liquorice, peppery tannins that combine fresh and crisp structure to perfection. Deep cherry red with purple tints, and a complex and refined bouquet of ripe red fruits, black cherry, blackberry, spices and vanilla. Silky attack, then rich and elegant mouthfeel, with the same flavours wrapped in full, well-integrated tannins. Fresh and well-balanced on the long mineral finish.
