



Château Vessière Mas de Vessière AOC Costière de Nîmes

In the heart of the Costières de Nîmes, in the southern reaches of the Rhône Valley, Château Vessière covers an area of 65 hectares of vines. Located at the gateway to the Camargue, the estate enjoys an exceptional climate and terroir.

The property initially belonged to Lucie Teulon, née Lucie de Vessière, and has been passed on in the family from generation to generation. In 1975, Philippe Teulon took over the reins after studying oenology at the Montpellier Science Faculty. Over time, Philippe shared his passion with one of his sons, Vincent who in turn studied oenology in Montpellier and went on to explore the latest techniques in the Napa Valley, California. Since 2007, Vincent and his wife Lucie have continued the family's history. Together, they have improved working methods, in particular by making the estate organic and taking responsibility for the company's commercial development.

The AOC Costières de Nîmes wine shows the singular nature of a terroir in the Rhone Valley. Located on a vast terrace of pebbles deposited by the Rhône and Durance rivers, it is the southernmost of the Rhône vineyards. Stony red clay and pebble soil produce a convection effect, amplified by the large stones in the vineyard which radiate heat back at night.

The wine offers a floral bouquet associated with delicate and long lasting aromas. It is a fragrant, fruity, refreshing, dry white wine with orange blossom, lemon citrus and passionfruit notes. Easy drinking, and pairs nicely with white meats, salads, fish, seafood or soft cheeses.
