



Denbies Surrey Gold NV

A floral English white bursting with hints of lemon and elderflower.

Established in 1986, Denbies Wine Estate is England's largest single estate vineyard with 265 acres of vines. Situated on the North Downs with its famous chalky soil, in a protected valley of south facing slopes. Denbies produces some of the finest sparkling and table wines in Europe through repeated certification in major International competitions, including the International Wine Challenge and International Wine and Spirit competition; and "food miles" of course are also low!

Surrey Gold has been in production since 1990, and is England's best selling wine. Located on the flat land with sandy limestone (perfect for fresh and light wines like this), the wine is a blend of Müller-Thurgau, Ortega and Bacchus. It has a herbal, fruity, citric quality, with lovely fresh elderflower aromas. Fresh, clean, light and balanced, with a fragrant nose of violets leading to a well structured fruit driven palate with a flinty backbone and hints of ginger.

Excellent aperitif, or try with smoked fish or Asian / spicy food.
