



## Domaine de Lauriers Cuvee Baptiste

An old favourite, their wines continue to improve. They have converted to Agriculture Raisonnée, which minimises the use of pesticides and concentrates on preserving the environment. As is so often the case, the wines seem to have become even better!

This family-run vineyard is situated in gently rolling countryside, near the delightful old Roman town of Pézenas, some 15 miles from Montpellier. The 45 hectare estate was founded in 1969, starting with just a few parcels of land, and the family have gradually purchased more vineyard land, as time has passed.

Shale and sandstone terroir, with early green harvest followed by manual harvest and bunch selection. The mix of grapes deploys a wide palette of aromas: white flowers, beeswax and citrus flavours together with apricots and white pepper. This complexity is echoed in a full mouthfeel, with a lovely bittersweet twist at the finish. Serve 10-12°C to accompany fish especially shellfish, or a little more chilled as an aperitif.
