

Domaine de Lauriers Picpoul

An old favourite, their wines continue to improve. They have converted to Agriculture Raisonnée, which minimises the use of pesticides and concentrates on preserving the environment. As is so often the case, the wines seem to have become even better!

This family-run vineyard is situated in gently rolling countryside, near the delightful old Roman town of Pézenas, some 15 miles from Montpelier. The 45 hectare estate was founded in 1969, starting with just a few parcels of land, and the family have gradually purchased more vineyard land, as time has passed.

Green citrus aromas, with an appealing minerality and saltiness on the nose; the palate has clean refreshing acidity and medium length. Serve as an aperitif or with light fish dishes.

"This wine from up in the back hills of the appellation is pithy and yeasty-fresh, with a spicy lemon-orange note which almost reminds me of wheat beer. There's dancing acidity and a pungent finish." 89 points - Andrew Jefford, Decanter
