

Domaine de Lauriers Viognier

An old favourite, their wines continue to improve. They have converted to Agriculture Raisonnée, which minimises the use of pesticides and concentrates on preserving the environment. As is so often the case, the wines seem to have become even better!

This family-run vineyard is situated in gently rolling countryside, near the delightful old Roman town of Pézenas, some 15 miles from Montpelier. The 45 hectare estate was founded in 1969, starting with just a few parcels of land, and the family have gradually purchased more vineyard land, as time has passed.

Light straw in colour, it has a young and powerful nose with plenty of fruit and floral notes. On the palate it is archetypal Viognier with apricots and greengages - round, full flavoured and with plenty of aromatic fruit. Drink with all fish at 10-12 degrees, or serve as an aperitif a little cooler.
