

Domaine Girard Chardonnay

Domaine Girard first started producing wine in 1928, when Jean Girard founded the winery. He first only had 7 hectares of land where he grew Carignan, Cinsault, Aramon, and Jurançon. The real turning point in the success of the winery came during the 80s thanks to André Girard. André is a third-generation winemaker from the Girard family and he brought innovation into the traditional winemaking techniques of the winery.

Grown at high altitude, in the areas adjacent to Limoux, this Chardonnay is then left on the lees in 500L oak barriques.

Tasting Notes: Rounded aromatic stone fruit flavours, pears and a good helping of citrus perfectly balanced with a touch of subtle oak. The aging on lees adds extra depth, texture and body making this a truly stunning chardonnay. Similar to a good white burgundy just without the price tag!
