



## Domaine Girard Pinot Noir “Pech Calvel” 2013

Not far from the historic city of Carcassonne, the region of Malepère has had a VDQS classification for many years but the consistent high quality of the wines resulted in its elevation to full appellation status just two years ago.

Pinot Noir is not the first grape one thinks of in the Languedoc, but to every rule there’s an exception. However, it has to be classified as a vin de pays d’Oc – no reflection of its quality! Having spent ten months in barrel this has a classic strawberry / black cherry nose and drinks beautifully now. Pair with white meats, grills, cheeses – a lovely refreshing red.
