



Domaine Meyer–Fonné Reserve Riesling 2014

Pay attention all you Riesling lovers. Felix Meyer has made yet another great Riesling in 2014. Racy and elegant, complex and balanced, with stunning aromatics, it represents the perfect expression of its terroir. This “reserve” bottling is a blend of multiple terroirs, including grand cru sources, vines young and old.

Félix Meyer is well known in Alsace. He’s the third generation vigneron since his grandfather founded the domaine in the late 19th century. He’s been in charge since the early nineties and is based at Katzenthal; he has invested heavily in continuing to improve quality and expanding the family’s holdings.

This Riesling is produced from varied plots and is pale straw in colour. It has aromas of nectarine, grapefruit and lime with, naturally, great minerality due to the influence of Katzenthal's granite soils.

On the palate with wine is bright and pure with lovely weight and balance and a refreshing, sherbet-like acidity. Great quality dry Alsace Riesling which will improve until at least the early 2020s.
