



Lucha Rossa dry farmed Carignan

Made with Carignan grapes from unirrigated vineyards nestled into Curico's coastal mountains. The Carignan is blended with 15% Grenache to flesh it out and give it some juiciness. Lucha Rocosa means "rocky struggle" and refers to the deep roots the vines have to develop in order to produce grapes that have great intensity and concentration as a result.

The wine has good acidity and tannins but also has a lovely purity of blackberry and mulberry fruit and a long, fresh finish leaving you wanting more!

This needs to be paired with gutsy, rustic food - cassoulet, slow-cooked shoulder of lamb with herbs and garlic or spicy bean casserole
