



2013 Single Vineyard Semillon Sauvignon Blanc

Semillon and Sauvignon blanc are flavour soul mates and this is the classic combination of great white Bordeaux

The Semillon vines are grown in sandy loam over gravel; Sauvignon Blanc F4V6 grown in gravelly loam; All blocks are cane pruned and have low yields. Each block is picked individually based on flavour and acid.

Following harvest the fruit is chilled and lightly pressed before being settled in tank. 50% of the Semillon is fermented in new French oak barriques the remainder fermented in tank (partially wild). Left on lees until blending, each parcel of fruit is kept separate until blending. No acid adjustments were made, minimal fining, minimal sulphur addition.
