



Porta dos Cavaleiros Dao Colheita

Caves São João has one of the oldest cellars in Portugal which reflects their history and reputation in Portugal. Founded in 1920, they have recently celebrated their Centenary, now more than 100 years since production began.

Touriga Nacional is the great undiscovered grape from Portugal and this wine is a great example of the most highly prized grape in the Dão region. The complex aromas are a joy to discover and are a mixture of raspberries, ripe blackcurrants, herbs and orange blossom.

Touriga Nacional has been discovered by new world wine producers and can be found in Chilean and New Zealand wines but the Portuguese still make the best and this is one of them in a traditional bottle with a lovely cork label.

It has won many awards including the Mundus Vini International Silver Medal and was voted one of UK wine merchants top 50 wines in a recent poll.
